## Know the Rules

### Distance Measuring Device?

**Q1.** May a Committee, by Local Rule, permit the use of distance-measuring devices?

**A1.** Yes. A Committee may establish a Local Rule allowing players to use devices that measure distance only. However, the use of devices that gauge or measure other conditions that might affect a player's play (e.g., wind or gradient) is not permitted.

In the absence of such a Local Rule, the use of a distance-measuring device would be contrary to Rule 14-3. (New)

**Juniper Golf Course has adopted this as a local rule.**

### Juniper Golf Club Dress Code

Appropriate golf attire is required at all times on the property of Juniper Golf Club.

Men: Shirts must have a collar and sleeves (mock-turtleneck and turtleneck style collars are acceptable). Shirts must be worn at all times. Tank tops, sleeveless shirts, cut-offs, bike shorts, gym shorts and swimwear are not appropriate attire.

Women: Golf shirts and sport shirts with or without a collar and with or without sleeves (material must cover shoulder) are acceptable attire. Halter tops, tops with narrow straps or that expose the midriff, swimwear, cut-offs, bike shorts, and gym shorts are not appropriate attire.
